

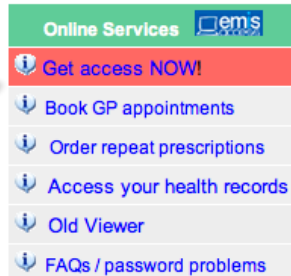
Get access to your GP electronic health records today

There are 4 steps for you to get access to your records

1. Get your **PIN NUMBERS** from the receptionist and register online following the instructions
2. Go to www.htmc.co.uk and click on "Get Access Now" next to the picture of Dr Hannan on the left


