1. Collect your PIN NUMBERS from the receptionist if you have not done so already
2. Register with your PIN NUMBERS including your PASSWORD
3. Complete the ONLINE QUESTIONNAIRE
4. Complete the CONSENT form including your PASS PHRASE and hand it in to the surgery.


